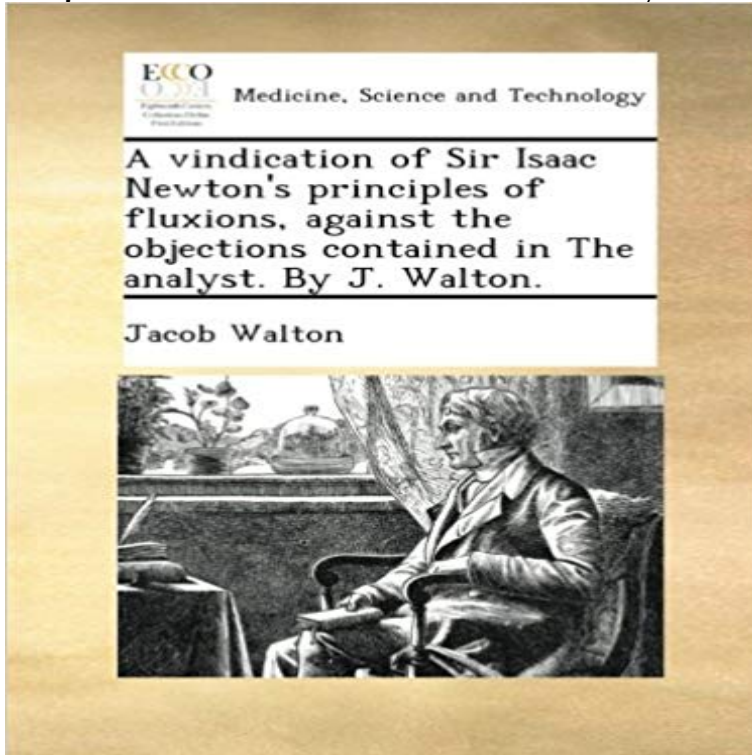


A vindication of Sir Isaac Newtons principles of fluxions, against the objections contained in The analyst. By J. Walton.
