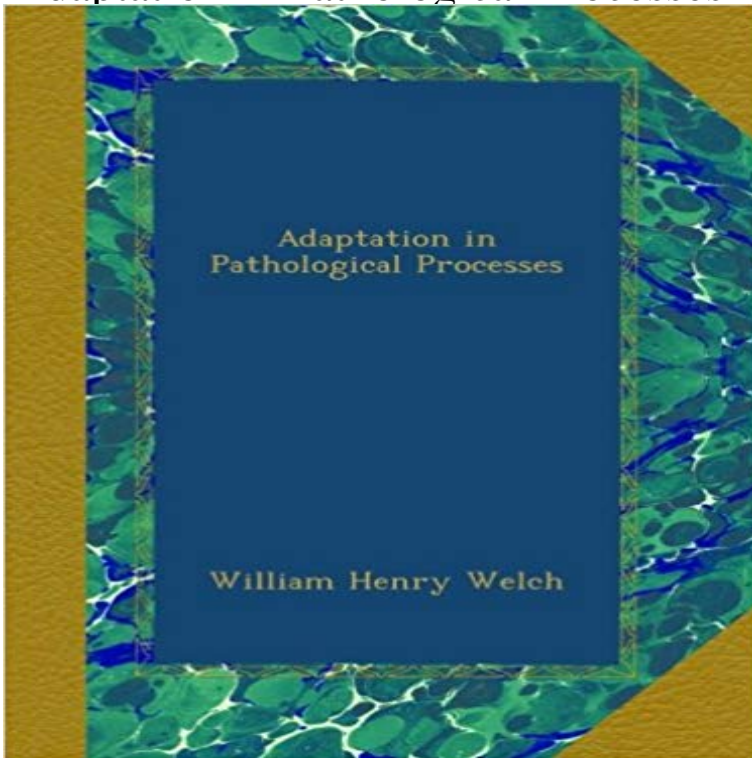


Adaptation in Pathological Processes
