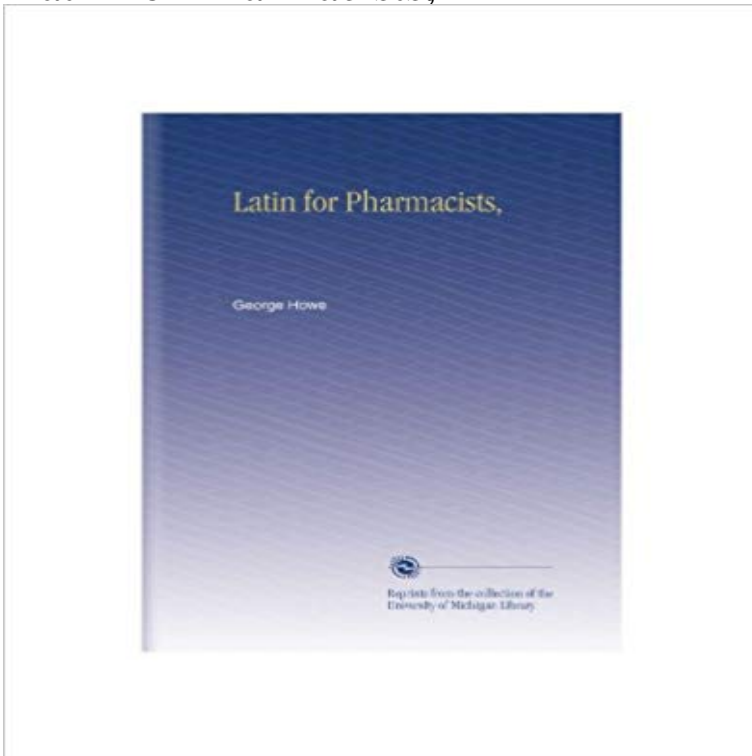


Latin for Pharmacists,
