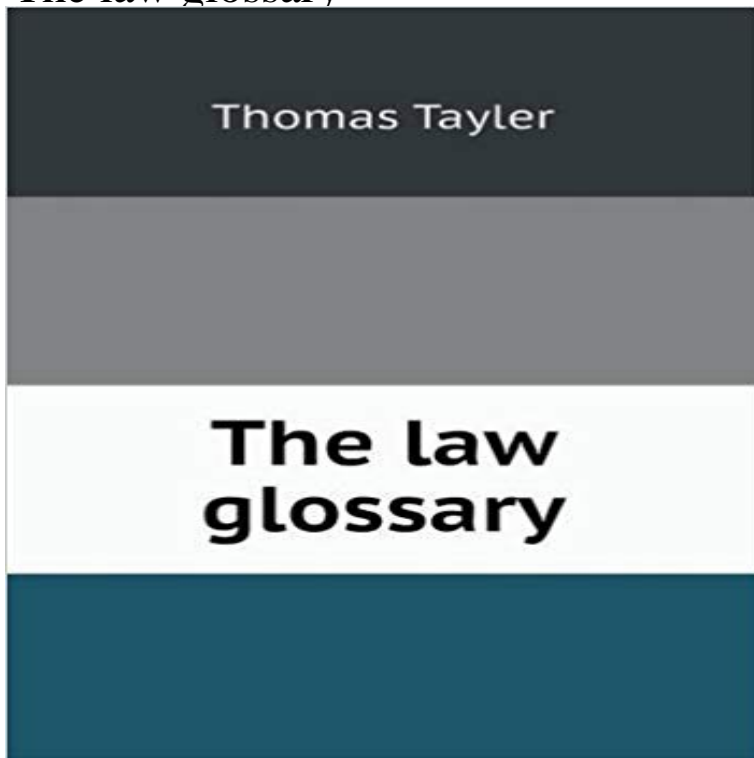


## The law glossary
