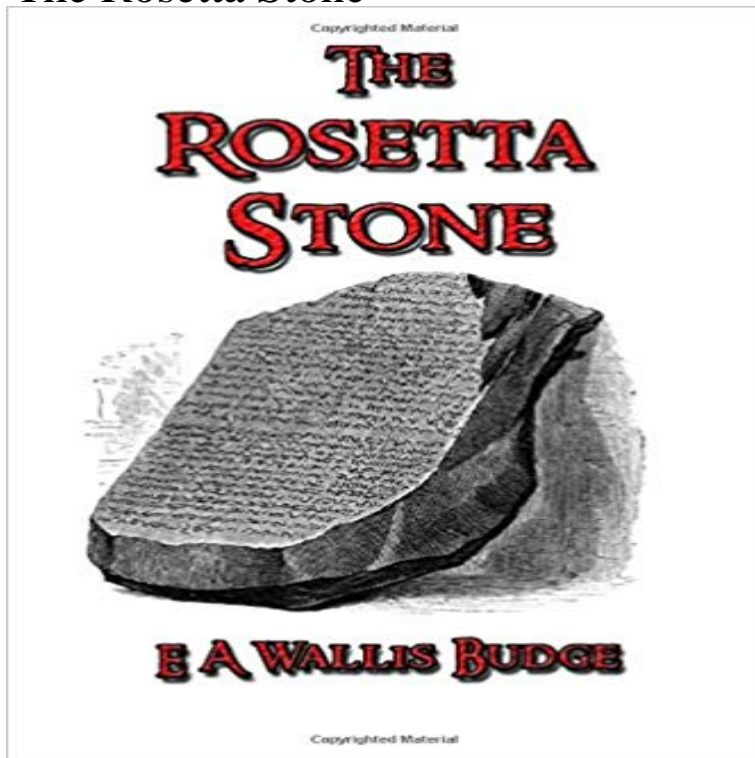


The Rosetta Stone
